**Business of the Board**

**C. Update on compost**

- not a part of the waste district so can't technically bring compost to town recycling center.
- waste district says that current truck picking up at Glover town is full.
- waste district will charge \$13 for each tote (\$540 per year).
- storage space for tote inside shed is also tight.

**A. Roof**

- flat section is most important. Have \$91,000 and another \$10,000 coming at beginning of next year.
- have some other money in current year budget that may not get spent including some in professional services, repairs and maintenance and fuel.
- taken altogether, we will have enough to probably do the whole flat roof.
- since only have one bid, will need a waiver
- Richard motions to accept bid for Rodd roofing \$123,460 for flat roof pending approval from State. Theresa 2nd. All in favor.

**B. Principles Salary**

- some schools have exceeded raises that were agreed upon. Others have given 4%, we offered 3.5%.
- This will mean that Angelique will be making less than other principles with less experience.
- Richard makes motion to increase 4%. Theresa 2nd. All in favor.

**D. Art Teacher**

- Emily Corkins. 1st year teacher. Will do one day here and one day each at two other schools.
- Theresa motions to hire Emily per negotiated agreement. Richard 2nd. All in favor

**E. Guidance**

- Stephanie currently working south of us 2 days a week. We are offering 3. She has provisional certificate and it is up at end of next year. Will need training in bullying.
- Theresa motioned to hire Stephanie Lingenfelter, guidance per negotiated agreement. Richard seconds. All in favor.

**F. Evacuation**

- have full evacuation drill on Wed May 30 at 2:30 pm. Parents and busses will pick up at evacuation site which is at Town Hall.
- Letter will go out to parents and local newspapers will be notified.
- Will impact preschoolers and high schoolers.
- Fire and EMS and Sheriffs will all be involved.
