

2018 TOWN SCHOOL DISTRICT MEETING MINUTES

Irasburg, VT

The legal voters of the Town School District of Irasburg are hereby notified to meet at the Town Hall in Irasburg Village on Tuesday, the 6th day of March 2018 at 6:00pm to transact the following business, namely:

Ron Holland called the meeting to order at 6:00pm
100 voters were present at the meeting.


1. To elect a Moderator for the ensuing year. Peter Limon nominated Ron Holland, there were no other nominations. Ron Holland was elected as moderator for the ensuing year.
2. To hear and act upon the reports of the district officers. Amy Leroux made a motion to accept the reports, Ron Holland seconded. Passed.
3. To elect the following officers as provided by statute
a.) A school director for a term of three years. Bev Johnson nominated Angelique Thomas, seconded. Angelique Thomas was elected School director for a three-year term.

4. To see if the District will vote to authorize the Board of Directors to borrow money to pay indebtedness and current expenses of the District. Larry Dwyer made a motion, Gary Bennett seconded. Article passed.
5. To see if the voters will authorize an additional Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000) to the capital reserve fund established by vote at the 2008 Annual Meeting pursuant to provision of 24 VSA section 2804; such funds to be used for repair, replacement and/or upgrading structural components of operating systems of the Irasburg Town School District. Robin Beaton made a motion, Robert Wesoja seconded. The following people spoke on the article; Gordon Chadburn, Amy Leroux, Lynn Brochu. Article passed.
6. A.) To have presented by the Board of School Directors their estimate of expenses for the ensuing year. Jennifer Edlund made a motion, Robin Beaton seconded the motion.
Amy Leroux presented their estimate of expenses for the ensuing year.
b.) Shall the voters of the school district approve the school board to expense \$1,984,342 which is the amount the school board has determined necessary for the ensuing fiscal year? It is estimated that this proposed budget, if approved, will result in education spending of \$13,194,43 per equalized pupil. This projected spending per equalized pupil is 1.16% higher than spending for the current year. Dale Leroux made a motion, Robin Beaton seconded. Article passed.
7. To see what date and time the Annual School District meeting will be held in 2019. Robin Beaton made a motion to hold the meeting the first Tuesday of March 2019 at 6pm at the Irasburg Town Hall, seconded by Dale Leroux. Article passed.
8. To act on any other business, which may legally come before, said meeting. Peter Limon asked how Act 46 would affect our school district. It was explained that there will be


community meetings and a vote on the subject in November. Wanda Lanou and Matthew Baughman also commented on this question.
