<ul> <li>Teachers create a positive and accepting environment for 'pushing yourself', regardless of background.</li> <li>The culture around athletics is that sportsmanship is more important than winning.</li> <li>Teachers create environments that are conducive for holding difficult conversations around gender identity, mental illness, disability, race, etc. without fear.</li> <li>Bullying and harassment around gender and sexuality does happen, especially online, but is dealt with appropriately when brought to the attention of an adult.</li> <li>It can sometimes feel uncomfortable or unsafe to share political views in class that are different than some teachers' perceived views.</li> </ul>

<b>Annual Meeting Format:</b> Jason Racine moved to hold the Lake Region Union High School Annual Meeting in February in person in the gym, with appropriate masking and distancing measures. It was seconded by Michael Sanville and approved unanimously.
