Dave Blodgett called the meeting to order at 6:17pm.

Additions: Jesse asked about adding "Maple in Schools" to a future agenda. He says LR has not been buying maple for school meals.

Consent Agenda: Jason/Mike - approved

Old Business:

Committee Assignments: Waiting for Barbara Postman and she's not present so add this to the next agenda.

Policy Review: Motion to approve revisions to all the policies as printed in the agenda - Jason/Mike - approved

Motion to approve the hiring of Katherine Powers as the part-time (30 hours/week) Community Service Coordinator beginning July 1, 2021 at a rate of \$22.50/hour. Jason/Mike - Some discussion describing what students do for community service. Students are required to do 80 hours of community service beginning the summer after 8th grade. Approved

Administrative Requests/Reports:

Graduation - Very successful graduation, it was the shortest one ever at one hour and 15 minutes. The video can be seen on the Lake Region website. You can also see the list of scholarships and who received them, and photos of the graduation. Andre showed the drone video that Walter Earle took. The cost was about \$9,000 more than we usually spend on graduation. Most of this was spent on the 4 tents that we rented.

Romeo and Juliet - Last Friday and Saturday, Lake Region Theatre did this as a feature film. Andre played the trailer for the film. It was in the gym Friday night (it was raining) and outside under the stars on Saturday night. It was filmed at locations around the community. Johanna Pastel adapted the play to be set in the NEK during the 1920s and the two feuding families were whiskey runners. LR musicians did all the background music. Proceeds (\$1200) are going to the Old Stone House. There were 8-9 key adults in addition to all the students who participated.

Summer School started today: math classes, driver's ed, credit recovery, tech apps

Excavating for the paving project is due to start next Monday.

Gazebo will be redone using ESSER funds. There will be a concrete slab poured for the floor and it will be larger than the current area. This will be an alternative learning space and will have shades that can be drawn so that it can be used during 3 seasons.

Gym floor will be done end of July.

Fall plans - planning on business as usual.

Andre let the board know that former LR principal and OCSU superintendent, Richard Aubuchon, passed away over the weekend.
